After our great turnout in early October, we're excited to announce that every first Wednesday of the month is Walk and Roll to School Day at Weibel. We want to see more students and parents walking and riding their bikes to school! We know bikes need a lot of maintenance and that's why we've invited The Safe Routes to Schools BikeMobile to provide free tune ups for all parents, students and staff at our school.

If your bike or your child's bike is making one of those mystery sounds or collecting dust because it has a flat tire, bring it to school at 8am on Wednesday, November 4th. The BikeMobile can fix flat tires, adjust brakes and gears, and even replace broken or worn out parts like chains, seats, and tires. The only thing it can't do is replace missing wheels or gears. While the mechanics work on your bike they'll explain how it works and how to keep it running smooth. Bike or no bike, everyone is welcome to stop by the BikeMobile to learn about maintenance, safety, and more!

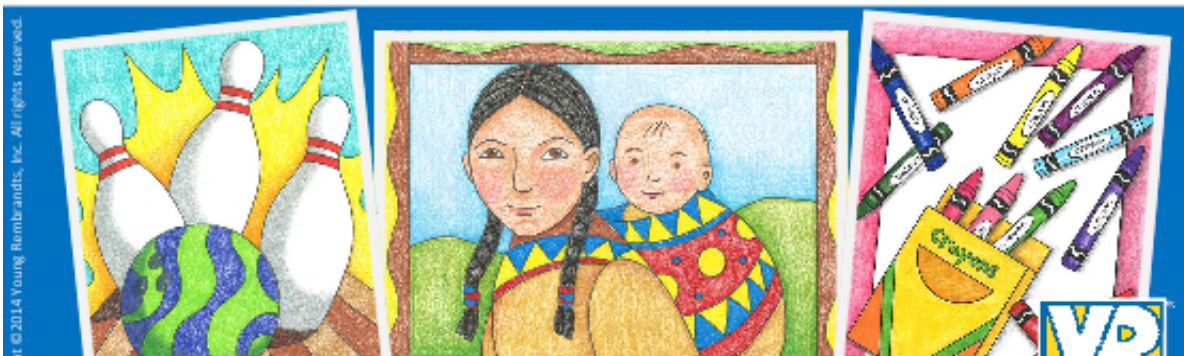
